

# Supply List

All supplies for both oils and acrylics are below.

## **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

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You don't need to have a wide range of colors or buy everything listed. Below are a few options for paints and brushes for the class. You can choose from professional or student grades based on what suits you best. The minimum paint requirement is to have white, blue, yellow, red, and either brown or black for paints.

### **What to bring to class:**

- Sketch pad to take notes as well as to draw thumbnails sketches for composition
- Pencil
- Brushes, paint, and odorless mineral spirit (see notes below)
- Feel free to bring your own reference material for your drawing or painting projects
- Choose the canvas/panel sizes that you feel most comfortable with, and feel free to bring a few different sizes along!

Please read the supply list carefully.

The supplies listed below are designed to help you succeed in class, ensuring you choose the right brands for brushes, paint, and more, while saving you money on trial and error with less effective products.

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## Brushes: Best for oils and acrylics

The brush brands I prefer are Grey Matters, Rosemary and Co, Robert Simmons bristle brushes, and Silver Brush Bristlon® All Media Brushes.

Size brush recommendations: Liner/round (size 3-6), a filbert (size 8-12), and a flat bright brush (size 6-12). These are the suggested size ranges I recommend. If you have more brushes, please feel free to bring them.

This is optional but highly recommended if you plan to continue painting as this will save you \$\$ in the long run. Purchasing both allows you to reuse the Gamsol cleaner for brush cleaning, and you can keep it in the container with the lid on to preserve it.

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**Oil Painting Palette** : I prefer glass gray palettes for oil paints, though paper gray palettes are acceptable for class. My 50% gray glass palette helps me see values. I create my own by having glass cut at Lowes and painting the back with 50% gray acrylic, or I can buy a pre-made one.

**Palette Seal Box** - I keep my palette in an artist palette seal box and my paints usually stay good up to a week in the freezer. Helps reduce the waste of paint.

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**Below is my current palette with my oil paints**

I use a variety of brands and I am currently using Micheal Harding, Rembrandt, and Winsor Newton.

**My current palette includes** Titanium White (Rembrandt), Ultramarine Blue (Rembrandt), Tera Rose (Winsor and Newton) , Cadmium Yellow (Winsor and Newton), Quinacridone Red (Gamblin), and Ivory Black (Michael Harding).

**Sometimes colors** like Cadmium Deep Yellow,,Viridian (Rembrandt), Burnt Umber, Yellow Light, or Winsor Yellow are also good options.

**Not required - For a transparent color**, I like using Transparent Red Oxide by Rembrandt for the underpainting (I do a very light wash).

Please note these are just recommendations and personal products I have tried and used.
